HISTORY VICTORIA SUPPORT GROUP

The History Victoria Support Group (HVSG) is a committee of the RHSV and comprises of volunteers actively involved in their own local historical societies.

The HVSG provides assistance and encouragement in various ways to those historical groups affiliated with the RHSV. The aim of the HVSG is to offer workshops and seminars to small network groups, or to associations of historical societies, however they are grouped.

The HVSG responds to requests from societies for assistance, guidance and training in the day -to-day running of their historical society and heritage group.

Each year the HVSG plans four Seminar Days, held in different parts of Victoria, on topics of interest for local historical societies and similar groups. The Seminar Days are completely free, with catering costs being the only charge, and any profits from catering returned to the host Society.

The Local History Officer is a part time member of staff employed by the RHSV. The Local History Officer supports the work of the HVSG and works more closely on an individual basis with historical societies. A particular strength of working with the Local History Officer is cataloguing and IT support, information on grants, online communities and web2.o. On line communities can be found at My Connected Community (mc2).



Formed in 1909, we are the centre of Victoria's history movement, encompassing over 1000 individual members, and the peak body for over 300 local and specialist historical societies across Victoria.

RARE HISTORICAL COLLECTION

We have a significant collection of books, manuscripts, directories, letters, journals and diaries, newspapers, shipping cuttings and the Victorian Pioneers' Register.

The picture collection is outstanding and includes thousands of photographs, drawing, artworks, postcards, maps and parish plans.

A research service is also available for individuals, as well as business clients and government agencies. Phone (03) 9326 9288 for costs and further details.


